

**Conference on Fourier Analysis and Pseudo-Differential Operators
25.-30.6.2012 in Otaniemi, Espoo, Finland.**

The ECM 2012 satellite meeting on *Fourier Analysis and Pseudo-Differential Operators* will be held on Monday to Friday 25-29 (with conference trip on Saturday 30 June) at the Otaniemi campus of Aalto University (street address Otakaari 4, Espoo), 10 km away from the center of Helsinki, the capital of Finland.

How to get to central Helsinki?

Arrival by air: The Helsinki-Vantaa international airport is located 15 km north of the center of Helsinki. Taxi to the city center costs about 30-40 euros, and it takes about 20-30 minutes depending on the traffic. The bus line 615 (or in night-time 620N) leaves every 15-30 minutes, and travels between the airport and (the east side of) the Central Railway Station (4 euros, 30-45 minutes). Finnair City Bus (line 620) leaves every 20 minutes (6 euros, 30 minutes, route Airport Terminal T2-Airport Terminal T1-Ooppera-Hesperianpuisto-Central Railway Station (west side)).

Arrival by train: Helsinki central railway station can easily be reached e.g. from St. Petersburg by train (3 hours) or Moscow (overnight), and naturally from most places in Finland.

Arrival by boat: There are plenty of regular boats connecting Helsinki to e.g. Stockholm, Tallinn, St. Petersburg, Travemunde etc. The passenger harbors in Helsinki are well-connected to the center by public transport (trams, buses).

Public transport in greater Helsinki area (Helsinki, Espoo, Vantaa)

The most useful website for "how to get from A to B" by bus, train, metro or a tram is <http://www.hsl.fi> (type street addresses, date and the time options). A single ticket within one city ("Zone 1") costs 2.70 euros and is valid for 60 minutes after purchase/stamping, and a single ticket in the whole greater Helsinki area ("Zone 2") costs 4.50 euros and is valid for 90 minutes. During the late night (2am-4:30am), some extra charges may apply in public transport. For most participants, it is cheaper to buy x-days-tourist-ticket ($0 < x < 8$, 1 day=24 hours, validated on first use) costing $(1+5*z/2)*(x+1)$ euros, where z is the zone number ($z=2$ needed when travelling from center to the campus or to the airport!). Tickets are available at R- kioski, VR's booking offices, Stockmann department stores, K-Citymarkets, Helsinki City Tourist Office, Tourist information at Helsinki-Vantaa airport and at HSL's service points at the Central Railway Station. The conference takes place at the Otaniemi campus of Aalto University in Espoo, while most of the hotels and cultural events are located in Helsinki. The airport resides in Vantaa. Thus many participants will benefit from "Zone 2" tickets.

How to get to Campus?

The conference venue at the street address Otakaari 4 is opposite to the Aalto School of Science main building, Otakaari 1. The main building (red bricks with a quite distinctive shape) is easy to recognize from almost any direction: then you know where to get out of the bus (which otherwise could take you far away from the university).

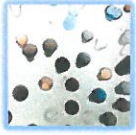
From airport: By taxi (30-40 euros, 30 minutes). By bus, in average the most convenient way is to go to the center of Helsinki and take another bus there, see below.

From center: Plenty of bus lines (bus time 20-35 minutes, take you to the Otaniemi Campus: e.g. 102 and 103 from the Kamppi bus station, 194 and 195 from (the west side of) the central railway station. Buses 102T/103T/194A/195N are slower (than the corresponding 102/103/194/195) by couple of minutes due to slightly longer routes, but are also good options should you encounter them.

From "Töölö Towers" Hotel: Either walk along the Hesperia Park to Mannerheimintie to catch buses 194 or 195, or walk to the Kamppi bus terminal for buses 102 or 103.

From Tapiola (e.g. Sokos Hotel Tapiola): Make sure that you take the buses to Otaniemi direction (roughly towards east). Any of the following bus lines will do: 10, 15, 194, 194A, 195, 195N, 550.

ECM 2012 Satellite, Helsinki, Essential Sights



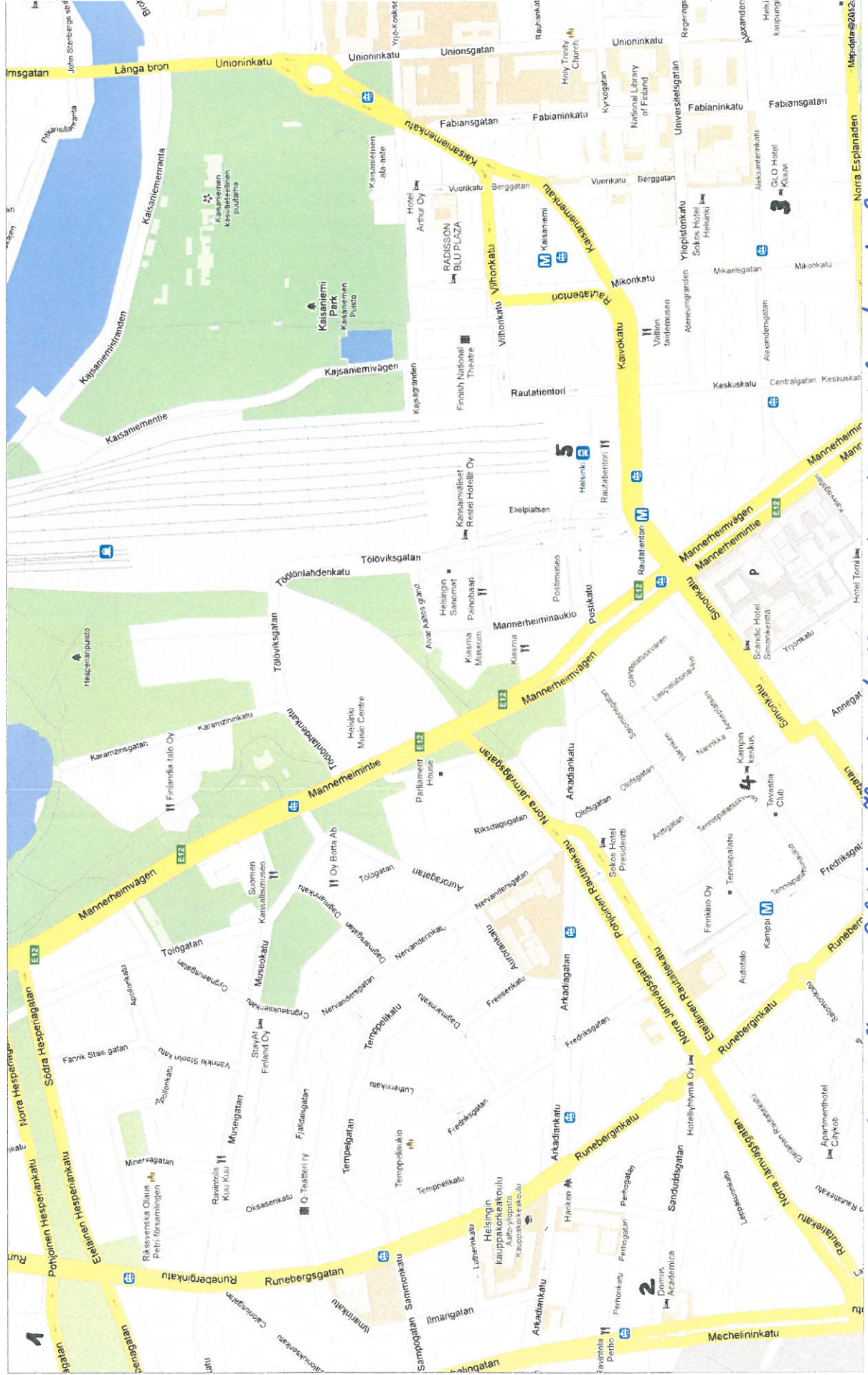

- 7. Parliament House-** Mannerheimintie 30 tel. +358(0)94322027 Sessions of the parliament can be observed by the public on Tuesdays and Fridays.
- 8. Helsinki Senate Square-**situated in the centre of Helsinki, the Senate Square comprises the Palace of the Council of State on the east, the University building on the opposite side as well as the Helsinki cathedral on the north.
- 9. Esplanade Park-** situated in the heart of Helsinki, the Esplanade serves as a promenade for tourists and a place to relax for city residents.
- 10. Market Square-** Helsinki's most famous market sells traditional market foods and treats, as well as handicrafts and souvenirs. Open: Mon-Fri 6:30am-6pm, Sat 6:30am-4pm, May-September also Sun 10am-5pm.
- 11. Finlandia Hall-** Overlooking Töölönlahti Bay is the famous concert and meeting hall designed by legendary Finnish architect Alvar Aalto. Mannerheimintie 13 E, tel. +358 (0)9 40241 Open: Mon-Fri 7:30am-5pm.
- 12. Seurasaari open-air museum-**Opening hours 15-31 May and 1-15 September: Mon-Fri 9am- 3pm, Sat-Sun 11am-5pm Opening hours 1 June-31 August: Mon-Sun 11am-5pm Prices: €6/5, visitors under 18 free of charge, free admission with the Helsinki Card. Free admission to the island. To get to Seurasaari, take Bus 24 from beside the Swedish Theatre in the city centre.

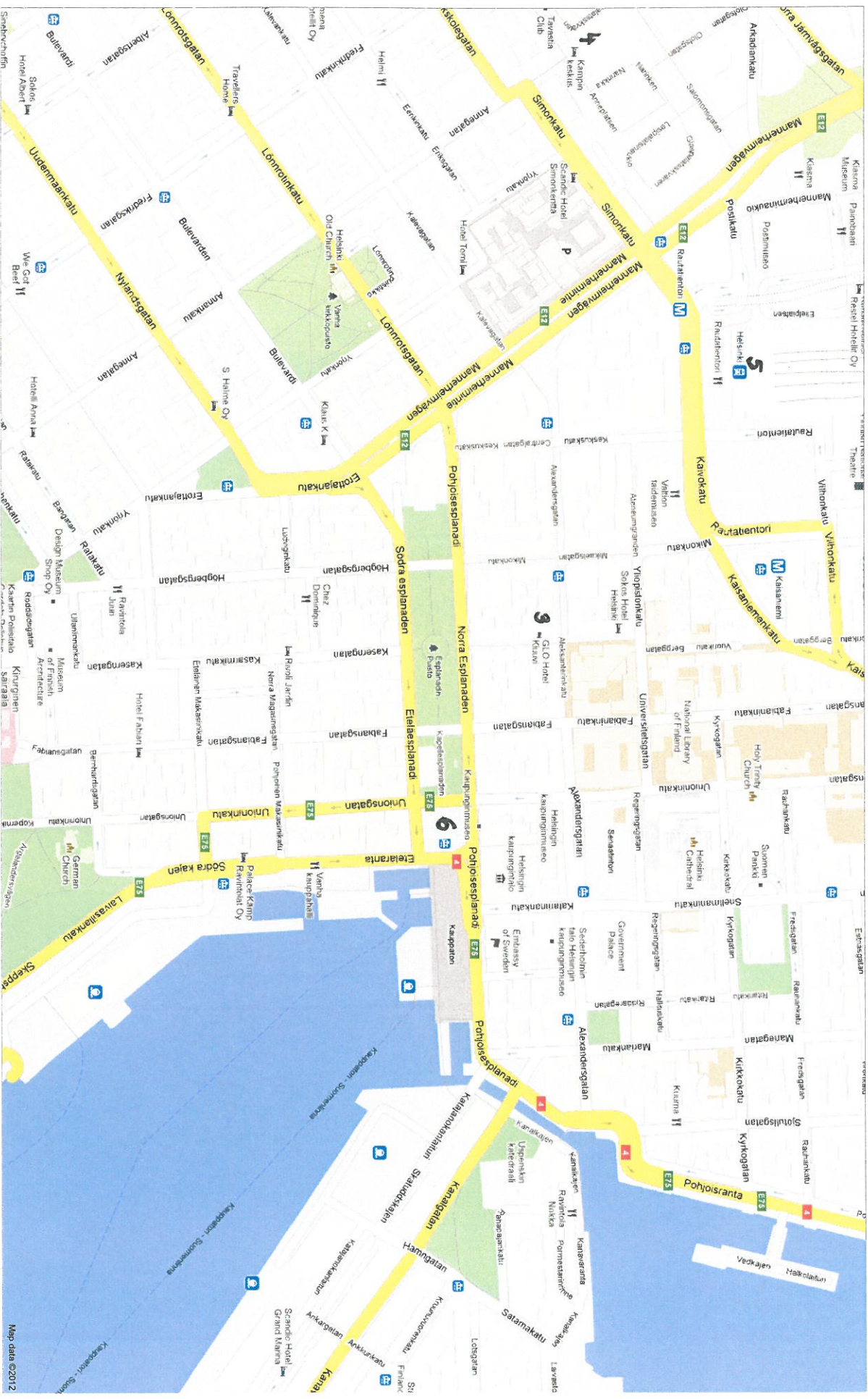
